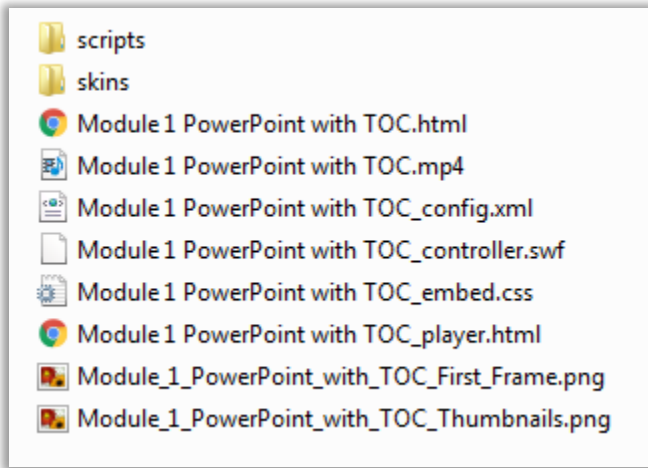


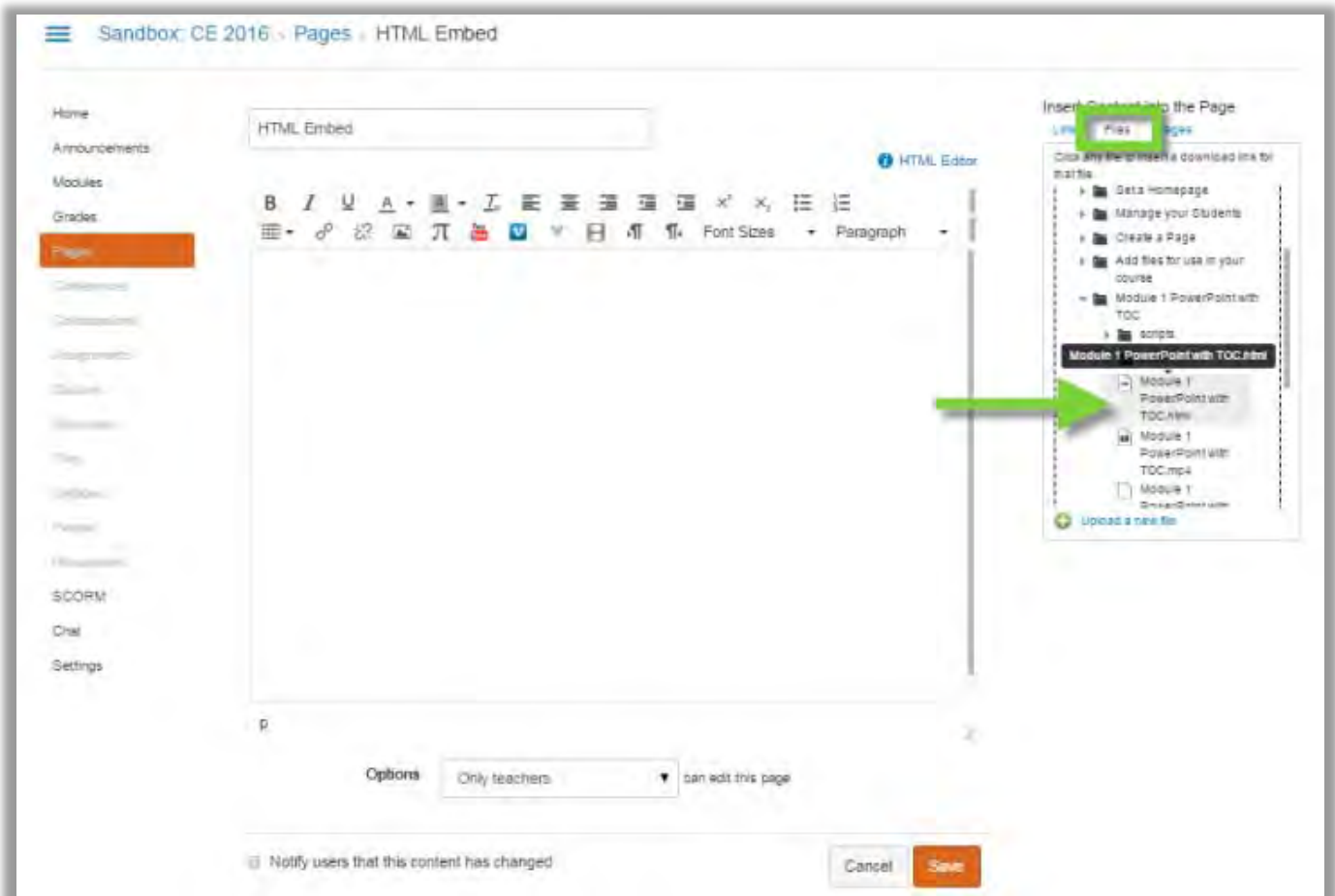
**Issue:** Linking html pkg files in **Files** and presenting in frame on **Pages**

We use Camtasia to record our online lectures – these are not assignments but lectures for distance learning students. The export from Camtasia that maintains the necessary and desired navigation and captioning for ADA compliance is an html5 zip pkg – example here

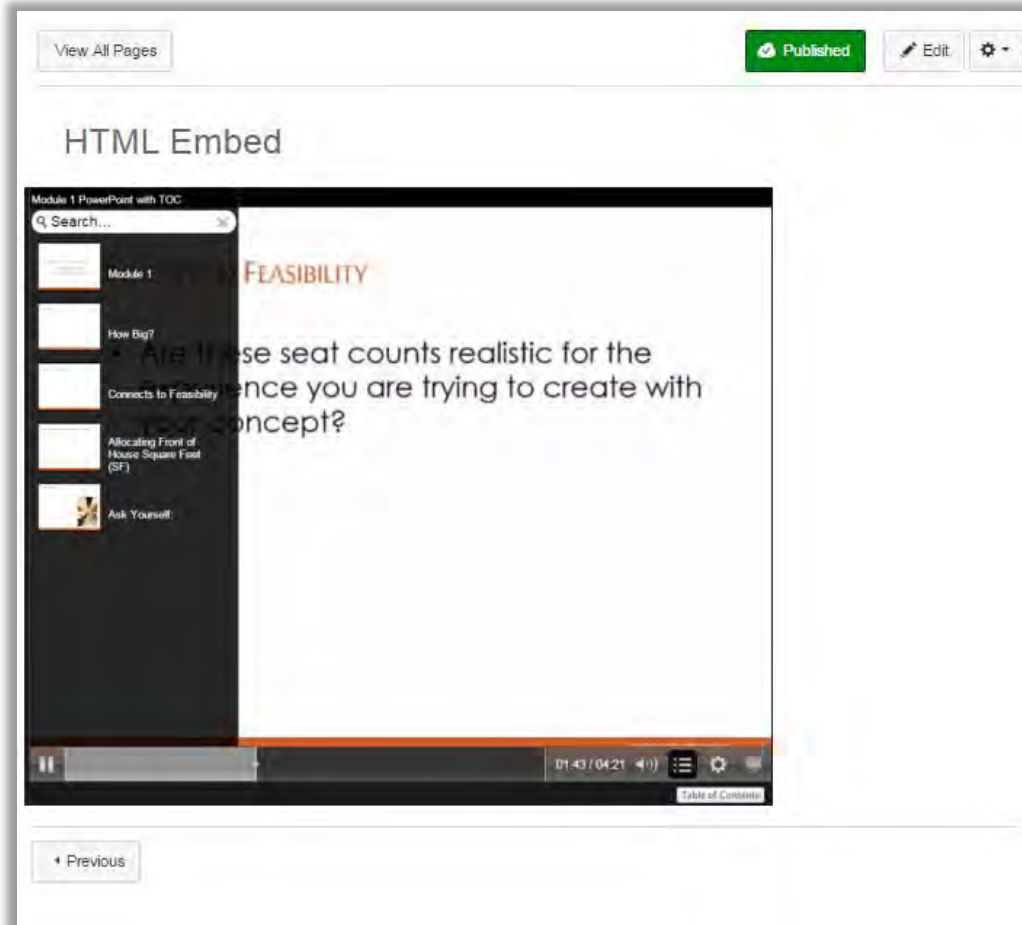


The desired [and common in most other LMS platforms] process for this would be to

1. upload and expand the zip pkg to Files and then link to the main.html file via a content Page



2. The desired outcome is for students to view the lecture in frame on a content Page so that they can easily navigate to and from this presentation – example



What exists now is

1. You cannot embed the html in the Page – you can only add a "link" to open the presentation – shown here



2. And – **and most critical and urgently in need of remedy** – is that the presentation loses all of its necessary navigation and there is no way to close or navigate away from the presentation – shown here
