## How Bluepulse Works



1 Students submit up to one suggestion, per course, per day. They have a maximum of 160 characters so it's important to be concise, constructive, and on-topic.



2 Instructors review students' suggestions to identify common themes in their feedback. This can be done in real-time or at the end of the day when instructors have a free moment.



3 Instructors publish a maximum of 7 opportunities for improvement based around student feedback. Instructors also have the freedom to create their own opportunities for improvement should they require.



4 Students can rate once a day, per opportunity, per course. Until the end of the day, students may alter their rating or even abstain. At the end of the day, each vote is tallied.



5 Continue and repeat. Students and instructors can track improvement over time with easy to read bubble charts and line graphs.
