#### 10. Use Quiz Statistics



The quiz statistics page shows the average score, the high score, the low score, the standard deviation, and the average time it took students to take it. You can also view a question-by-question break down.



# 11. Weight Your Assignments

You can weight final grades by creating assignment groups. Tests, quizzes, and homework assignments can be divided into assignment groups and be given particular weights.

# 12. Add Your Own Apps



If your Canvas administrator has not added an app you would like to use (and it is free), you can do that yourself. Here is how to add Flipgrid to your Canvas assignment.



#### 13. Export Grades

You can export scores from the Gradebook and download them to your computer as a CSV file.

### 14. Use Peer Review Discussions

If you would like students to provide feedback on other student's work, use a peer review discussion. Peer reviews are a great tool that allows students to learn from each other.



#### 15. Print a Quiz

@ChadScottKISD wrote a script that you can use with Tampermonkey to print a quiz from the preview page. Add the Tampermonkey extension and add the script.

### 16. Add Sound to Pages



Something fun to add to your course is a short 2-3 second sound effect when students open a page. When students finish a quest or a mission in your gamified course, a short crowd cheering sound effect could be added.
